Siamak Bahram, MD, PhD, is Professor of Medicine (Immunology) at the Strasbourg University School of Medicine and Teaching Hospitals, Strasbourg, France. He is a senior member of the "Institut universitaire de France" (IUF) and Dean of Research at the medical school. He graduated from the Strasbourg School of Medicine upon which he did his PhD work at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute – Harvard Medical School (Boston, USA). Upon returning to Europe, he accepted a position as a member of the Basel Institute for Immunology (Roche, Basel, Switzerland). He then moved back to Strasbourg, first as an Associate and then full Professor at the school of Medicine. Additionally, and since 2003, he is the head of the Department of Immunology at Strasbourg University Hospitals. His research aims at understanding the genetic basis of the immune response in man with emphasis on histocompatibility genes, governing graft rejection as well as the genetics of auto-immune and auto-inflammatory diseases in man. He is the director of INSERM Unit 1109, the Laboratory of Excellence (LabEx) Transplantex and the Franco-Japanese FJ-HLA laboratory. He is intensely involved in several international research projects with colleagues in Europe, North America, and Asia.
